We are planning the Zero Year reunion to be a large alumni and student mixer to launch Alumni Weekend. We anticipate 500-700 students will attend.

We plan to hold this event in the Millberry Gym. For the Alumni Office or Alumni Association to rent it, it costs \$5000. For a registered student organization to do so, it costs \$1000.

We asked the two student organizations GSA and ASUC – which collectively represent the entire student population – to each apply for \$500 grants, totaling the \$1000 needed for the rental. The AAUCSF representatives Kate Lovero and Wesley Yu did so as a favor to us. The money saved will allow us to produce a better event.

Secondarily, this represents an important partnership between the student organizations and the alumni association and co-sponsorship increases the strength of our partnership.

We strongly endorse the approval of these grants.
