Advocacy Committee

• The Advocacy Committee serves to advance the University's legislative interests in local, state, and federal governments, maintaining a network of alumni advocates. The Committee encourages greater alumni participation in advocacy through contact with public policymakers; creates interaction with alumni and elected officials and the campus administration to give voice to the alumni body; supports alumni advocacy events and activities, and plans and participates in all Association involvement with public policymakers. The Committee also works in partnership with the UCSF Government Relations team.
